

2021 NAAB RESEARCH AWARD

The National Association of Animal Breeders (NAAB) has announced that nominations for the 2021 NAAB Research Award will be accepted until and must be received by **May 3, 2021**. Anyone who is interested in or associated with the artificial insemination industry or research and education related to the artificial insemination industry, animal physiology or animal breeding may submit nominations for prospective Research Award recipients.

Note: Pursuant to action taken by the NAAB Board of Directors in 2020, due to the postponement of the 2020 NAAB Technical Conference, the conference and this award will be presented in the odd years, in conjunction with the NAAB Biennial Technical Conference.

Basic qualifications of nominees for the NAAB Research Award are:

1. Shall have made a significant contribution to the science of artificial insemination, animal physiology or animal breeding in the United States.
2. Based on, but not limited to original published research and teaching. Cumulative contribution of the nominee's research to the A.I. industry to be a primary consideration.
3. Shall not have previously received the NAAB Research Award.
4. Must be living and currently active in his field of work at the time of nomination.
5. Nominees are not required to be U.S. citizens.

The award will consist of an attractive plaque and \$2,500 from NAAB. Presentation of this award will be made at the NAAB Annual Meeting on Thursday, October 28th, 2021 during a special luncheon.

- C. Your nominee's effectiveness as a leader and contributions to research projects.
- D. Your nominee's current and previous research programs.
- E. Any other information you believe would be useful.

4. LIST OF PUBLICATIONS

Please submit a list of publications your nominee has been included on. Use the following guidelines:

- A. Cite authors in order as they appear on the paper, the complete title of article, the journal name, volume number, first and last pages, and year.
- B. Include research papers presented at annual meetings of professional societies, indicating them by using the word "Abstract" after the title.
- C. Do not include popular articles written for trade journals, farm publications, or news releases unless they contribute to an understanding of your nominee's research. List these separately.
- D. Only list publications from the past five years.
